## OKLAHOMA MUNICIPAL POWER AUTHORITY POWER SALES RATE SCHEDULE Green Tags for Renewable Energy Sales

- 1. <u>Applicability</u>. This schedule shall be applicable for the sale of Energy Attributes (commonly known as "Green Tags") associated with electric energy generated by the Authority's renewable energy resources and delivered to the Customer for municipal use and redistribution to retail customers.
- 2. <u>Availability</u>. This schedule is available to any entity purchasing power and/or energy from the Authority under the terms of a Power Sales Contract ("the Contract").
- 3. <u>Billing Rate</u>. For Certified Energy Attributes furnished hereunder, the charges for each billing period shall be determined as follows:
  - a.) For electricity purchased from the Authority or under a Southwestern Power Administration contract supported by the Authority, an amount per kilowatt-hour ("KWH") per the following formulas:

## **Energy Attribute Charge:**

Renewable Energy Attribute Charge =\$0.00025 per KWh

- b.) Such charge shall be in addition to any charge made under any other Contract the Customer has with the Authority.
- 4. <u>Billing Energy</u>. The Billing Energy Attributes for any billing period shall be the Energy Attributes for which the Customer has signed a confirmation to purchase said energy in blocks of 1000 kWh's. A minimum of 10,000 kWh per month shall be ordered. Said Energy commitment may be changed with 30 days notice. Once confirmed by the Authority, such Energy Attribute Certifications shall be delivered by the Authority, along with the appropriate billing, absent Force Majeure conditions. In cases of over subscriptions of available Energy Attributes, the Authority will prorate the requests, based on availability and total requests.
- 5. <u>Late Payment Charge</u>. The Authority may impose monthly late payment interest charges on the total of a) any outstanding balances not paid when due, and b) any prior unpaid late charges, at a rate equal to one-twelfth of the prime rate (in effect at the time of late charge calculation) of a bank designated from time to time by the Board of Directors of the Authority for this purpose; provided, however, in no event may the rate of such late payment charge be in excess of the maximum rate allowable under applicable law. The Authority shall apply any payments received first to any unpaid late payment interest charges, then sequentially to the oldest unpaid bill.

6. <u>Billing Period</u>. The billing period shall be in accordance with a schedule established by the Authority.
